PILOT OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES--A/OA-10(PACAF)

COMPLIANCE WITH THIS INSTRUCTION IS MANDATORY.

This instruction implements policy guidance in AFPD 11-2, Flight Rules and Procedures. This instruction prescribes standard operational and weapons employment procedures to be used by all pilots operating USAF A/OA-10 aircraft. Units may supplement this instruction using Chapter 8, MAJCOMs may supplement using Chapter 9. This instruction applies to Air National Guard (ANG) units when published in ANGIND2. It applies to United States Air Force Reserve (USAFR) units when published in AFRESIND2. Each pilot is authorized a copy of this instruction.

NOTE: This publication incorporates PACAF's Chapter 9 using the paragraph supplementation method. **Supplemental material is highlighted in BOLD type and prefaced with (PACAF).**
